## **Senior Information Sheet**

### **About us**

Glenbrook-Blaxland Cricket Club (GBCC) has been part of the lower Blue Mountains community since the early 1970s. Formed in 2000, its parent clubs were Glenbrook Senior Cricket Club (1971/72), Glenbrook Junior Cricket Club (1977/78) and Blaxland Cricket Club (1983/84).

In the 2017/18 summer season, we fielded eight men's teams in the Nepean District Cricket Association competition and eleven teams in the Penrith Junior Cricket Association competition. We were also proud to have two all-girls team play in the Thunder Girls Cricket League.

GBCC has a proud and competitive history, and a reputation for outstanding sportsmanship. We've developed cricketing talent such as Australian representative Patrick Cummins; Sydney Sixers and Tasmanian cricketer Jordan Silk; and Australian, NSW and ACT cricketer Laura Wright.



### **Competition**

The season usually commences in mid-September and continues until the weekend before Christmas. Games recommence the second week of January with finals in early March. There are generally no games scheduled on the October long weekend.

### **Games**

Games are 40 overs per side and are usually played on Saturday afternoons. Ground availability may necessitate some Sunday afternoon games.

Fields are within a 25minute radius from Springwood (west) to St Clair (east), and from Castlereagh (north) to Luddenham (south).

## **Wet Weather**

All players must turn up at the ground before the game to decide whether it is possible to play. The captain will contact you if the game has been cancelled. DO NOT rely on the Penrith or Blue Mountains Council websites.

## **Committee**
